

DOMESTIC USES OF U.S. 10¢ 1869 STAMP

THIS STAMP WAS MOSTLY USED ON INTERNATIONAL MAIL. OF 1360 10¢ 1869 COVERS SO FAR RECORDED, FEWER THAN 50 REPRESENT FULLY DOMESTIC USES. THIS FRAME SHOWS COVERS ON WHICH THE 10¢ 1869 STAMP IS USED TO PAY VARIOUS MULTIPLES OF THE 3¢ LETTER RATE; THE SELDOM-SEEN BOOK RATE; AND THE SUCCESSIVE REGISTRY FEES OF 15¢, 8¢ AND 10¢. THE FRAME CONCLUDES WITH TWO COVERS FRANKED WITH 10¢ 1869 PLATE PROOFS (THE ONLY SUCH COVERS KNOWN) AND A VERY LATE USE ON A PATRIOTIC ENVELOPE PAYING THE SPECIAL DELIVERY FEE.

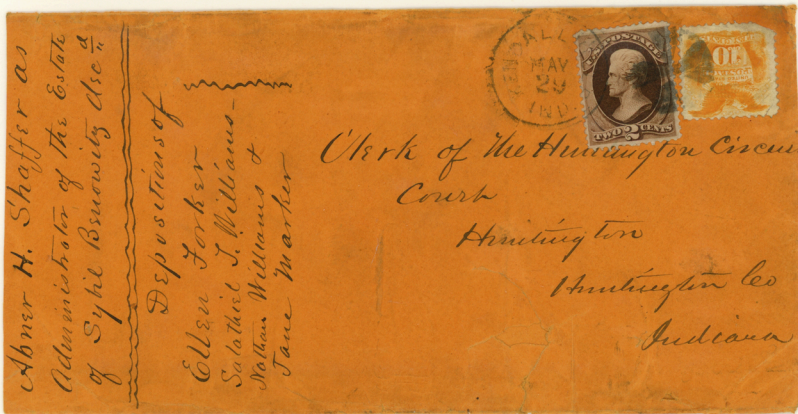

THIS CONFECTION, CREATED BY A STAMP COLLECTOR IN 1930, IS THE LATEST RECORDED USE OF A 10¢ 1869 STAMP, AS WELL AS THE ONLY SPECIAL DELIVERY USE AND THE ONLY USE ON A PATRIOTIC ENVELOPE.
